Bids will be evaluated using the following methodology:

- 2. Technical evaluation to determine substantial responsiveness to the specifications in the Statement of Requirements.
- 3. Financial evaluation and comparison to determine the evaluated price of bids and to determine the lowest evaluated bid.

Failing any stage of the evaluation process will lead to automatic disqualification and the bid will not be considered for subsequent stages.

Evaluation criteria

The Bids will be examined to confirm that all terms, conditions, and requirements of the bidding document have been complied with by the Bidder. The assessment of responsiveness shall be determined in accordance with the criteria in section 28 of the Regulations.

Review by the Special Procurement Oversight Committee

Section 54 of the Act provides for review by the Special Procurement Oversight Committee for certain especially sensitive or especially valuable contracts. This requirement will be subject to this review, and therefore in terms of the PPDPA SI 5 of 2018, 5th Schedule, Part IV, bidders are required to pay SPOC Administration Fee of \$200.00 upon submission of Bids.

Evaluation criteria

The Procuring Entity's evaluation of a Bid will take into account, in addition to the Bid Price, the following criteria and methodologies.

- (a) **Delivery schedule**: Time is of essence for this tender hence bidders are encouraged to input their best lead time.
- (b) Cost of major replacement components, mandatory spare parts, and service: Bidders must state the unit prices for any high-usage and high-value items of components and spare parts, along with estimated quantities of usage in the initial period of operation.
